

# HOW TO USE THIS BOOK

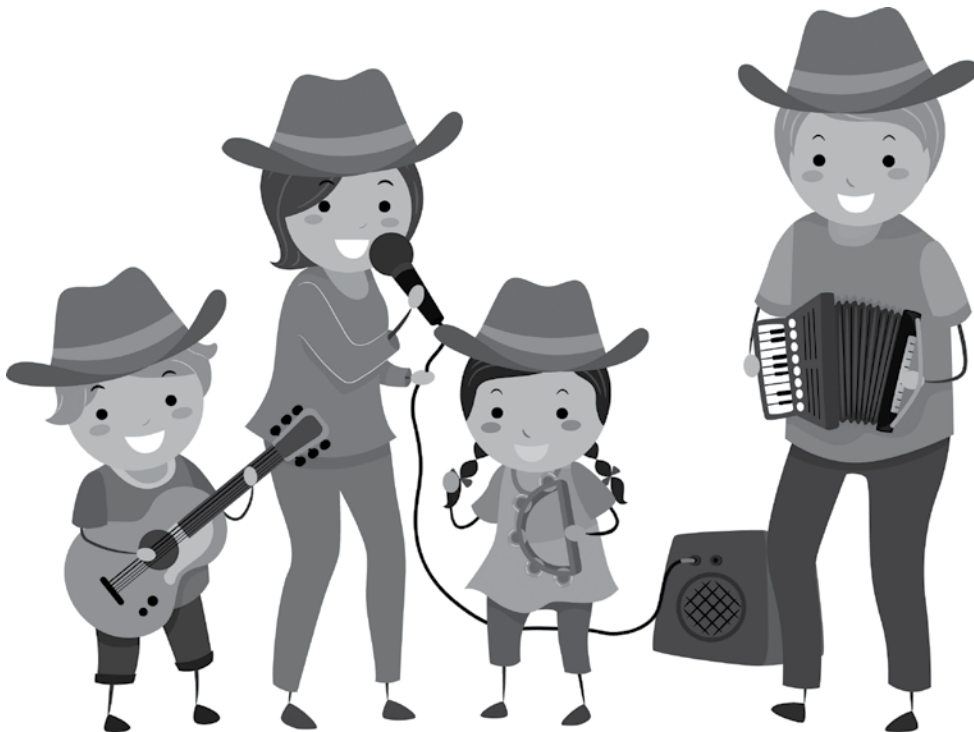

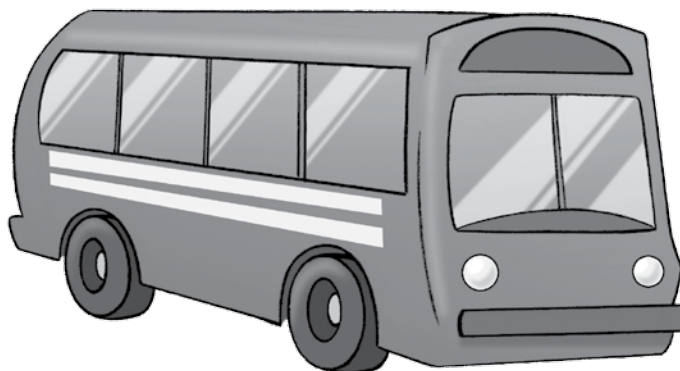
